WHAT: The founder of the global school-feeding charity Mary's Meals, Magnus MacFarlane-Barrow, will provide an inside view of war-torn Tigray, Ethiopia following his recent visit to the region. He'll discuss the work of Mary's Meals lifesaving school-feeding program in Tigray, where its trusted partner continues to feed more than 45,000 children every school day.
