## Evening of Hope with Lettie

A Mary's Meals film served with bread, soup and global love

Watch "Lettie," a new film sharing the story of one woman's courage, community, and the power of hope through daily meals for children.

### What Is an Evening of Hope?

An **Evening of Hope** is a simple gathering that brings people together to:

- Pray and reflect
- Watch a short Mary's Meals film
- Share a humble meal of soup and bread
- Learn how feeding children transforms lives
- Respond through prayer, giving, or advocacy



## Why Soup, Bread, and Film?

- **Soup and bread** reflect simplicity and solidarity with those who have less.
- **Film** allows us to listen deeply to the stories of children, families, and communities.
- **Community** reminds us that hope grows when we act together. This evening is not a fundraiser first — it is an *encounter*. Giving flows naturally from hearts that have been moved.

## Sample Evening Flow (60–90 Minutes)

### 1. Welcome & Opening Prayer (5–10 min)

Share the opening scripture or quote and a short prayer.

### 2. Film Screening (35 min)

Invite quiet reflection during the film.

### 3. Silent Reflection (2–3 min)

Allow a moment of silence after the film.

### 4. Soup & Bread Meal (20–30 min)

Encourage simple conversation and fellowship.

### 5. Guided Reflection or Discussion (15–20 min)

### 6. Invitation to Respond (5–10 min)

Share simple ways to support Mary's Meals:

- Prayer
- One-time or ongoing giving
- Sharing the mission with others

### 7. Closing Prayer (5 min)

**Pope Francis — Hunger as a Moral Issue** “Hunger is not a problem that can be postponed. It is a matter of justice.” — Pope Francis

**Saint John Paul II — Solidarity** “Solidarity is not a feeling of vague compassion...It is a firm and persevering determination to commit oneself to the common good.” — Sollicitudo Rei Socialis, §38

**Corporal Works of Mercy — Feeding the Hungry** “The works of mercy are charitable actions by which we come to the aid of our neighbor in his spiritual and bodily necessities...to feed the hungry...” — Catechism of the Catholic Church, §2447

## Check List: Film Screening

### Before the Event

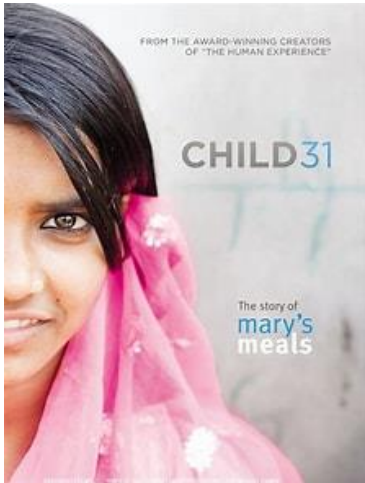
- Discovery meeting with venue sponsor/collaborator – parish, university, school, youth group, prayer group...
- Select a suitable venue and date.
- Send out Save the Date
- Promote event (use Eventbrite if appropriate for RSVP)
- Arrange for catering and refreshments.
- Organize transportation and parking arrangements.
- Production of event assets like posters
- Coordinate with Mary's Meals for fundraising page, Venmo, QR codes, books, flyers, stickers

### During the Event

- Open with Prayer (order the Mary's Meals Prayer Card)
- Booth and Event Assets set up
- Ensure all technical equipment is functioning properly.
- Welcome guests and provide them with event programs.
- Facilitate a discussion
- Invite attendees to become monthly donors, sponsor a school, become an ambassador or other.

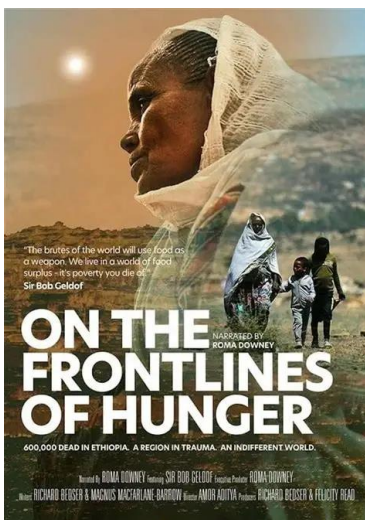
